ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

The University of Pittsburgh at Bradford and The University of Pittsburgh at Titusville

The University of Pittsburgh at Bradford (UPB) and The University of Pittsburgh at Titusville (UPT) set forth the conditions upon which UPB will consider graduates of the <u>Associate of Arts in Human Services program at UPT for admission into UPB's Bachelor of Arts in Human Relations program.</u> This document sets forth those conditions, which the parties hereby agree to.

A. Rationale for the purpose of the articulation agreement

This agreement applies only to the Associate of Arts in Human Services program that is currently constituted and delivered at UPT as of the 2002 - 2003 academic year. The purpose of this agreement is to make available to the Associate of Arts in Human Services graduates of UPT the opportunity to pursue a Bachelor of Arts in Human Relations.

- B. Description of how the agreement may be renewed or terminated
- 1. UPT agrees to promptly notify UPB upon any substantive curriculum modification to the Associate of Arts in Human Services program, and further agrees that the terms of this agreement will no longer hold unless UPB provides a written approval that the curriculum changes do not alter the intent of this agreement.
- 2. UPB agrees to provide UPT with information about the Bachelor of Arts in Human Relations program of study and any changes to the curriculum, should they occur. Conditions for admission into the Bachelor of Arts in Human Relations program are stipulated in section C of this document.
- 3. The terms of this agreement shall remain in effect, except as stipulated in certain previous terms as listed herein, until terminated by either party. Any party may terminate the agreement with or without cause, on the provision of 120 days written notice to the other parties.
- C. Admission requirements and transfer of academic credits
- 1. UPB agrees that graduates of the Associate of Arts in Human Services program meet the admissions standards of the Bachelor of Arts in Human Relations program given that they satisfy the following conditions:
 - a. Successful completion of 60 transferable credits with a grade of "C-" = 1.75 grade points or better:
 - b. A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or better.
 - c. Students must meet UPB conduct standards in regard to known behavioral problems.
- 2. UPB agrees that UPT's Associate of Arts in Human Services graduates who meet the above admissions standards and apply will be admitted into the Bachelor of Arts in Human Relations program provided the number of students admitted into the Bachelor of Arts in Human Relations program has not exceeded a pre-established limit.
