### Services

1. Provide a knowledgeable staff member to advise individual chapters & Greek Council
2. Provide a Greek Report Card to track progress in adhering to the founding values
3. Provide an annual Greek Awards program for adhering to our Founding values
4. Provide the Sorority & Fraternity of the Year with \$100 each for their composites
5. Provide the Advisor of the Year a \$50 gift certificate to Beef Eaters
6. Provide individual member GPA's to Chapter President & Advisor
7. Code Greeks on PeopleSoft for groups to track their alumni
8. Pay for mailings to alumni or send emails to alumni
9. Provide financial assistance for reunions
10. Provide an Advisor & Chapter Presidents luncheon each semester
11. Provide a Fall & Spring Greek Retreat to build community, set goals, budget & calendar
12. Conduct a Greek Council Officers Retreat in April when officers are elected
13. Provide President's meetings to build community & discuss important issues
14. Provide a Risk Management program each semester
15. Provide lists of eligible students for recruitment (name, hometown, major, email)
16. Send students to the Northeast Greek Leadership Academy in February
17. Provide a Facebook site for the Greek community & post regularly
18. Provide a Greek web site
19. Provide free weekly Pitt Purri ads
20. Provide 1 free banner or 2 free posters each semester
21. Provide room reservations
22. Provide a copy code to each Greek group
23. Provide tables at Club Night
24. Provide a system-wide composite deal to save groups money

### Requirements

1. Follow all UPB Policies including the Hazing Policy & Social Events Policy
2. Register your group each September through Pitt-Paws
3. Register all fundraisers through Pitt-Paws
4. Update your chapter roster by the end of the semester with Dr. Binder
5. Four members attend the Fall & Spring Greek Retreats
6. Chapter President attends the Advisors/Chapter Presidents semesterly luncheon
7. Meet with Associate Dean, NMO Director & Advisor to review your NMO program
8. Turn in the Hazing Compliance Form before NMO
9. Attend and financially support, through dues each semester, the Greek Council
10. Maintain a chapter membership of 5 or more members
11. Achieve a 2.50 semesterly GPA
12. Turn in information for the Greek Report at the end of the semester
  - a. Service hours & dollars raised for charity
  - b. A list of members who are involved in one other student group or athletic team
  - c. How much your chapter spends to reward members for good grades
