Pitt-Bradford Flu Shot Clinic

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How do I get a copy/verification of receiving my flu shot?

Ask Rite Aid staff for verification of your flu shot. They will provide you with a verification form.

2. What if I don't have my health insurance card with me on campus?

A photo copy or picture of your insurance card on your phone will work.

3. I am unable to print the consent form.

That's OK. We will have consent forms available the day of the flu shot clinic. Come a few minutes early to allow time to complete the form prior to your appointment.

4. I am a student and don't have health insurance currently.

Come anyway. There will be no charge to Pitt-Bradford students for their flu shot.

5. I am a staff/faculty member and don't have health insurance currently.

Please contact your Primary Care Physician or your local Department of Health office to ask about getting a flu vaccine.

6. I am a staff/faculty member. Can my family members come to the clinic to get their flu shot?

No. This clinic is only available to Pitt-Bradford faculty, staff and students.

7. None of these dates/times work for me. Will flu vaccine be available on campus on other days?

No. There are many ways to get your flu vaccine. You can contact your Primary Care Physician or local Department of Health office. Many pharmacies administer flu vaccine as well!
