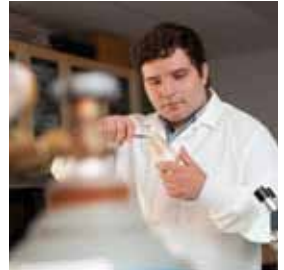
An education from Pitt-Bradford and a degree from the University of Pittsburgh will change your life.
